

Moving between fascinating memoir and searing analysis, and reporting on everything from a beauty contest in Ireland to South African townships, Younge shows how many citizens of the modern world - from the American conservative to the Islamic fundamentalist, from the established elite to the second-generation immigrant - are now retreating into their personal identities as a means of survival in the face of a state seemingly indifferent to their lives. In an argument that is brilliantly observed and deeply impassioned, Younge urges us to halt this retreat, to search for a common, higher ground, or be prepared to see a society more dangerously divided than ever before.
