Directions in Manchester, and to Workshop Venues

Once you arrive in Manchester:

If you arriving in Manchester by Air:

The easiest and fastest way to reach your hotel is to take a taxi from the airport to your destination. It will cost around £20 or a bit less.

If you are arriving in Manchester by Train:

Buses 142 and 42 are the most popular bus routes in Manchester. The bus stop is at a close distance from both Manchester Piccadilly Train Station, and Oxford Road Station. You will be arriving at either of these stations. You can take bus 42 or 142 to your hotel.

However, if you are staying at **IBIS HOTEL**, it is at a walking distance from both these stations.

To reach the workshop venues:

If your hotel is close to Oxford Road or Wilmslow Road (before Fallowfield), you can take bus numbers 42, 142, 43, or 143 to the university campus, or you can walk!

To reach the venues on 15th Nov.:

Both Humanities Bridgford and Kilburn Buildings are close to the <u>University</u> <u>Precinct Bus Stop</u>. Any of the above buses will go there. Once you get off the bus, Kilburn Building will be right in front of you, and Humanities Bridgford is close by. You can ask at Starbucks or Blackwells (which you will see once you get off the bus) about directions to get there.

To reach the venue on 16th and 17th Nov.:

Pease take any of the above buses and get off at the <u>Manchester Students Union Bus Stop</u>. You can also walk there if you like. Once you get off the bus, Ellen Wilkinson Building will be just behind the Students' Union building.
