#### COVID19

#### **Travel & Arrival Information**

#### Car

If you are travelling to the event by car please use the postcode LA1 4YB and head for John Creed Avenue to arrive for around 11-11.15am. At the end of the avenue you will see the Margaret Fell building (big wooden and yellow) and the doors to event the foyer. Our ambassadors will be on hand to greet you. Parking is free all day on a Saturday on campus.

#### Train

If traveling from London Euston – two ambassadors (in red hoodies with a sign) will be in the station outside the ticket office from 8am to meet you, please make sure you meet them or get on the 8.30am train even if you don't find them.

Arrival at Lancaster – A free coach to transport you to campus will be at the station at 11am. The coach will be parked on the bus stands outside the station (the entrance/exit on Platform 3) and our ambassadors and staff will be nearby. If you arrive early please use the waiting room/coffee shop until 11am. If you experience train disruption and are likely to miss the coach please let us know by calling/texting us on 07773098120.

Return to station - Coaches will be available to return you at the end of the event and you will arrive at the station about 3.30pm (or 4.30pm if you stay for a tour).

#### Bus

If you are arriving by bus you will arrive into our Underpass. Head up the stairs and along the spine walkway directly opposite Costa, you will go past Subway and keep going until you reach the big black and yellow Margaret Fell building on your right.

#### Coach

If you are on a pre-arranged coach from your school you will have been sent information about this in advance.

### Food/Dietary and Accessibility

All dietary requirements we have been informed of in advance have been passed to our catering team and will be provided for on the day. Please ensure you make the catering staff aware of your requirements when serving to ensure you get the right food. Of note all meals served during the event will be halal.

We have noted all medical and accessibility needs and these are held in confidence by our staff. If you have any issues on the day please let a member of staff or ambassador know and we will do what we can to make things as comfortable as possible for you. We will have a safe space/quiet room available all day if you get overloaded and need to take a break.
