Travel & Arrival Information

Train

Arrival at Lancaster – We will collect you from the train station on the Friday evening and have noted your arrival time. Our staff or ambassadors in red hoodies will meet you at the station to transport you to campus. Return to station – A coach will be available to return you at the end of the event on Saturday and you will arrive at the station about 3.30pm.

Overnight Stay

Your accommodation will be provided in our guest rooms on site. These are individual en-suite rooms with lockable doors. You will be in a flat with other members of the programme and also have nominated student ambassadors in the flat overnight. You will be shown to your room and we have a range of activities in the evening as shown in the timetable. A towel and bedding are provided in the room for you.

You will leave the room on Saturday morning following breakfast but secure luggage storage will be available on the day of the event.

Food/Dietary and Accessibility

All dietary requirements we have been informed of in advance have been passed to our catering team and will be provided for on the day. Please ensure you make the catering staff aware of your requirements when serving to ensure you get the right food. Of note all meals served during the event will be halal.

We have noted all medical and accessibility needs and these are held in confidence by our staff.
