- We will have an initial kick-off event full of inspiration and CPD. This will be on the afternoon of Friday 7th February 2025.
- Every term, there will be an inter-phase CPD twilight focussing on inspirational talks, project tools, checking in and other support. We will alternate between online and in-person twilights. The in-person twilights will take place in various locations around the Bay to ensure that we are representing the Bay fully and we will support transportation as much as possible.

What is asked of Working Group Members:

- To attend and participate in meetings of the Working Group for the agreed period.
- To work alongside other members to identify the area of impact the group would like to make. This could be a project, an area of curriculum development or a campaign.
- To follow up the actions you commit to in your Working Group meetings.
- To attend the termly inter-phase CPD twilight sessions (online and in-person).
- To help fly the flag for your age group, embracing the opportunity to connect your work to other ages and phases.
