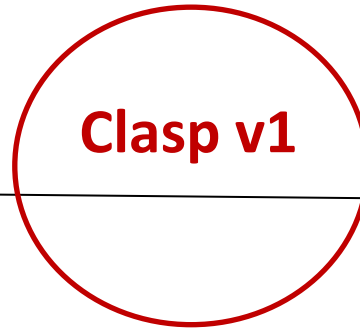

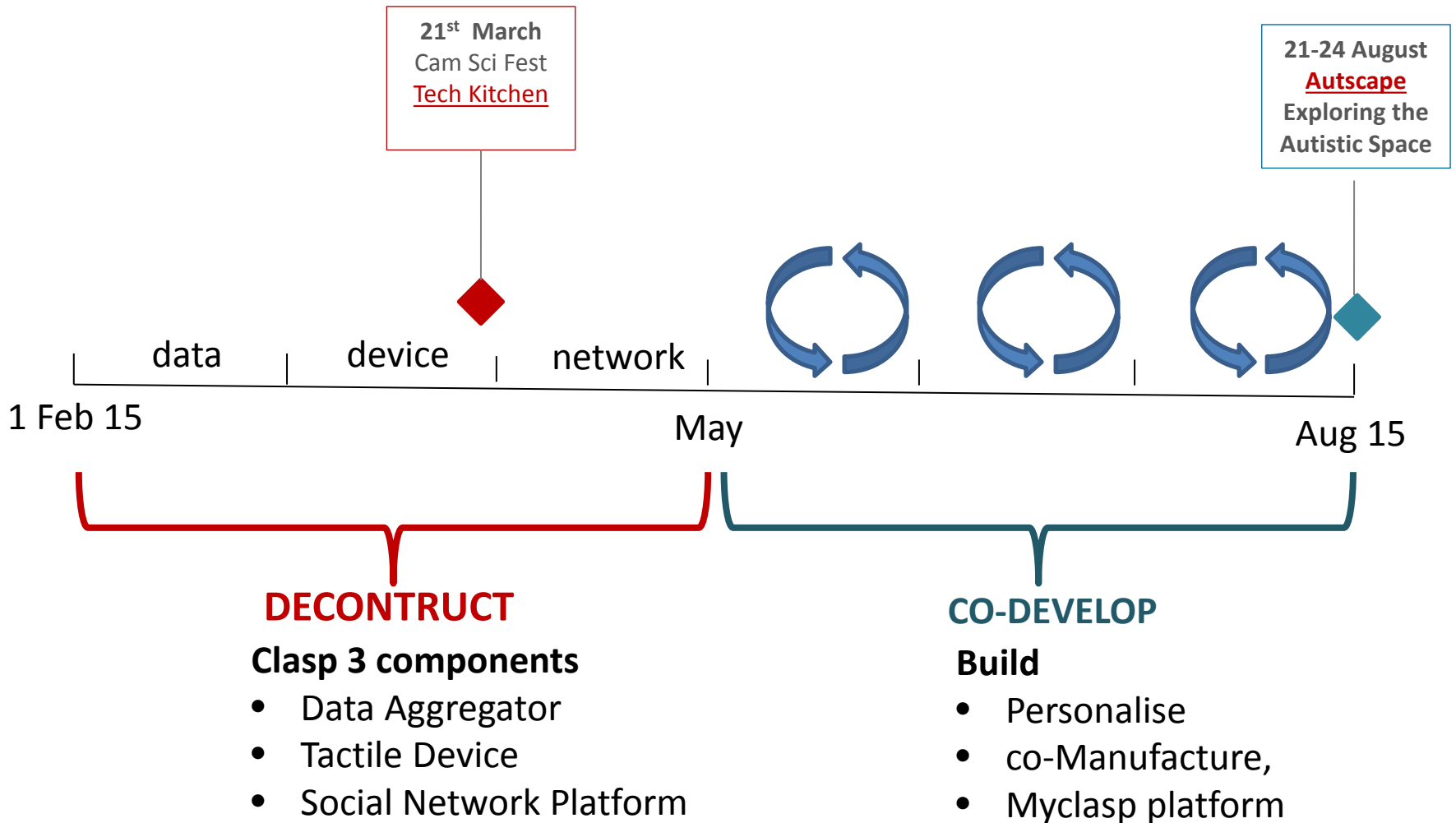

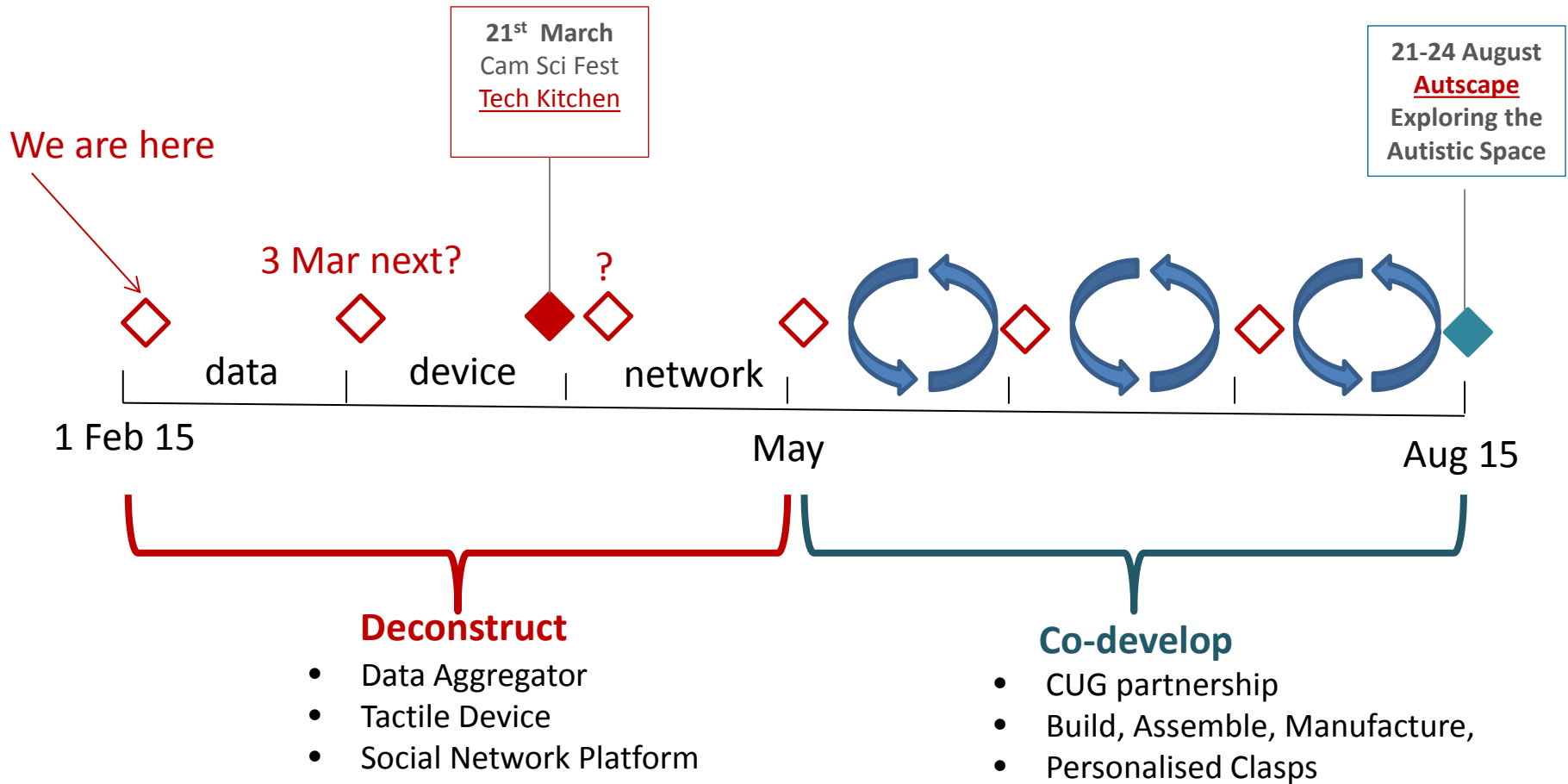

Task 4: 'Validate'

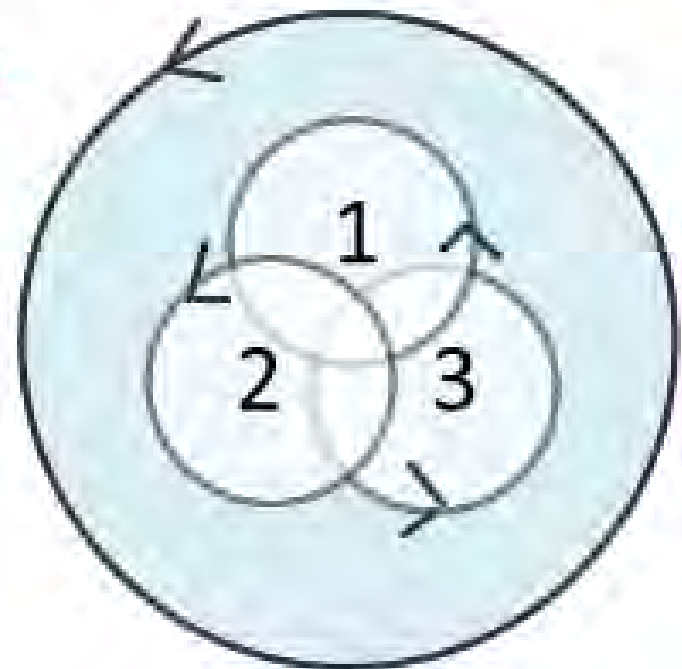
